The Visa-on-Arrival charges are as follow :

- a. US\$15 per person for a maximum period of 7 (seven) days.
- b. US\$35 per person for a maximum period of 30 (thirty) days.
- c. Please note that the visa is not extendable and cannot be used for employment purposes.

Visitors are required to have at hand the following documents for VOA application:

1. Passport with minimum 6 (six) months' validity.
2. Arrival / Departure Card.
3. Return or onwards journey ticket.
4. Visitors are advised to bring with them the exact amount in US Dollars for payment of VOA fees prior to departure for Batam / Bintan, so as to minimize inconvenience and ensure a smooth VOA application proceed.

Visitors from countries not granted Visa-Free and Visa-on-Arrival facilities will have to apply for an entry visa at the Indonesian embassies in their respective countries.
